Vicar's Message

Shoonoyo Lent (August 1-15)

"For He has been mindful of the humble state of His servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed." Luke 1:48

This is an excerpt from the song of St. Mary which is named the "Magnificat". This prayer confesses the magnanimity of God in the life of St. Mary. Two important thoughts are carved out of this excerpt:

1. God minds the humility of His Servant: St. Mary is known for her humility and unconditional submission to the will of God. All through her life, which was filled with unexpected suffering, she remained a humble person. She could have been proud as she gave birth to the Messiah the Savior but she did not take any pride



Jesus also that. underlined 'humility' in the mission of his life. He taught this to the apostles more clearly anything else even though initially they were unable to grasp it. We read the discussion among the apostles as to who is greatest among them. Mother of James and John even requested the seat on the left and right of Jesus in His kingdom. At the Last Supper the Lord showed the disciples the example of humility through washing the feet of them. And commanded them to do it between them. When St. Paul quotes the humility of the Lord in Philippians Chapter 2 he is underlining the utmost importance of the example of the Lord Himself. The end result of humility is not death but crown of glory. Cross or suffering and death may precede it. But humility will reap the fruit wherever it is exhibited. Therefore, what the Lord taught us in his life will be valued in His sight.

2. St. Mary predicts her names as 'Blessed': At the time of St. Mary's time or even in the first century no one knew this truth. St. Mary's prediction that she will be called the 'Blessed' for the rest of the generations did happen. Now we know that the entire world calls her 'Blessed Virgin Mary'. If we take the history of St. Mary's influence in the world, it is simply indescribable. The millions of miracles attached to her and the influence of her example in the life of millions of Christians and

non-Christians is It great. was unfortunate that the Protestant world somehow missed this part. The Bible is very vocal and strong in confessing Mary as the 'Blessed' whether some people like it or not. We are reminded of Elizabeth's statement the at meeting with St. Mary, "how blessed I am that the Mother of God to came to me" Luke 1:43. It is not a matter of argument at all whether St. Mary deserves the appreciation of the coming generations, but it is a simple fact. That is why the Apostolic Churches follow this biblical trail to exalt St. Mary as the most blessed. I am sure the Lord will honor those who honor His mother.

During the Shoonoyo Lent, between August 1 and 15, we will have a very meaningful time of meditation on St. Mary's virtue of humility. Hope such Lenten observance will enrich us.
