Vicar's Message

STIOC ANNIVERSARY FROM 1976

Looking through the history of our parish that started in 1976 October with Rev. Fr. K. Mathai (currently Very Rev. K Mathai Cor Episcopa) as its Vicar with the name St. Thomas Malankara Orthodox Church, we are standing at the gate of October 2018 with 42 years of history. Even though there some lack of clarity in the is metamorphosis of the Malankara Orthodox community in Philadelphia, one thing we know as members of the STIOC is that October seems to be the month of remembrance for us. We bought the present church complex in October and the church was consecrated in October as well. It was in the year 2004 that we had to change our name to St. Thomas IOC because of another parish with the same name existed giving some confusion at the State capital regarding the name.



When I began my service in 1996 in our parish 22 years ago, I had no idea where we were going! We were a small community of 28 families worshipping in a rented chapel of the Cardinal Dougherty High School. Because I had a job as librarian in North Jersey, I had to travel to Philadelphia to conduct worship for five years. Later I moved to Trenton, New Jersey and finally to Philadelphia. The parish was so kind to me in helping during my several moves from place to place. I could see the love and cooperation of ALL members in the parish matters. That love and cooperation were very clear when the church building was purchased. When we purchased the property we were only 76 families which was a huge growth from 28 within 8 years. Now we are more than 220 families from 76 to 220 in 13 years. These are all indications of physical growth of our parish through Divine Providence. In addition, two other reasons for our growth are:

- 1. The welcoming nature of all the members who came from time to time.
- 2. The unconditional acceptance given to each family that came to the parish.

I have always taught my people to love one another without any conditions because God loves us without any conditions. I still believe, it is the right policy even though at least some people have taken advantage of it. However, the bulk of our members have taken a very caring attitude.

We have now built a spiritual culture of our own and a style of activity for our parish. Very strongly rooted in the great values and traditions of the Orthodox Church, we grew to a much better witness. I am not interested in comparing us with other parishes but I thank God for His divine providence as reward to our unity and understanding for the successful

functioning. Perhaps some of our members have seen the positive side of smoothly functioning spiritual organizations, the Committee Managing and Board of and several subcommittees Trustees engaging in multifarious tasks. We have not ignored anyone but those people who just wanted to stay at the periphery all the time, may not have come into the main current like others. Again, compulsion was not our way! I have seen God blessing all those who took the parish seriously and worked with others. Indeed, when we grow bigger and bigger several changes will take place. It will not be like a small parish where everyone knows everyone. It is the homework that the Lord gives us to get in touch with more people as time goes on.

The pillars of our Church are the members and the clergy that worked harmoniously with them. I cannot thank them all enough. All of these I deem as great blessings from God. I am reminded of the priceless grace poured out on us. Let us stay in that positive power of the Lord to keep our parish in the right path of the Word of God. "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift." 2 Corinthians 9:15.
