It is so heartening to know that several of us are taking the Great Lent seriously and started observing it. In the Orthodox Tradition, Lent is a source of our spiritual strength, for those who seek it. For many it is just another season! For those who take it seriously, it proves as a beneficial factor in not only strengthening their spirituality but also strengthening their mental and physical life. In other words, Lenten time is a holistic exercise that helps us to full growth as a real human being. This concept of "real human being" is meant to say that the way the creator made us to function. Many people look real in exterior appearance but internally they are simply confused, destroyed, or even corrupted. They may well-dressed, good-looking, richappear looking, and will speak a lot of intelligent Many such people are words. professionals too. But if we get an opportunity to look into their inner "being" we know what is going on. Often it may not be as great as they appear.



(transformation) or change. These are human beings who love their own life and want to have a change from what they had been doing that is detrimental to their life. Many are under various kinds of addictions: it may be substance abuse, entertainment factors, sexual perversion, egotistic life pattern, arrogance, love for money (avarice), love for positions or recognition, and so on. They will have a metanoia (change of mind) when they start observing lent. This is possible for the wise people who rethink about their own destructive elements in life that they acquired with their addictions or evil circumstances. But those who continue to enjoy their addictions will not feel the need for any

change. It is not easy to get rid of addictions once it has grown to some measure. It is easy to stop in the initial stage. However, there is nothing that is "impossible with God". If a person truly wants to change their lifestyle, it is possible even though they will show some 'withdrawal symptoms'. Withdrawal symptom is a great tool Satan uses against us. Once we feel 'lost' then such symptoms appear. But those who truly draw their strength from God will succeed in fighting that symptom and gain victory.

The greatest opportunity that the lent gives us is to impose some small restrictions in our life. It may look simple like abstaining from a particular food item such as egg, fish, or meat. But what the restriction gives us is the power of mind to withstand the simple need which may look unimportant. For people who are so deep in their addictions abstaining from certain habits is tough. But when they slowly overcome their affinity to certain food items, it will give them the feeling of success and they can slowly overcome serious addictions as well. All that we need is to make our small strides. Slowly we will reach our goal.

Another opportunity that the Lent gives us is to pray longer hours. Maybe we don't even know what we are praying while reading the prayers in the book. But the time that we spend with God is a positive time when the mind is completely diverted to prayer. Prayer is not always an intelligent exercise but a time set apart to divert our attention to The Superior Power. Thus, our attention given to some of our evil habits will get reduced as we are spending less time on that. Every instance of prayer is an opportunity to connect with God. That in itself is a power.

Finally, the lent opens the softer part of our heart to see the needs of others who are less fortunate. God has given us many things to make our life comfortable and cozy, but we should not just be satisfied with our comfort. We should seek the comfort of others as well. That is a dominant idea in our Lenten prayer; our prayer should result in our charitable action. We fast in order to share our resources with others who don't have it. Without charity, our prayer is worthless. With prayer alone, we will never reach the favor of God. Prayer should lead to reconciliation, forgiveness, help, and love.

God bless you all to have a very blessed Lenten time.
