Assistant Vicar's Message

Growing Our Faith

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" (Luke 17:5). We should pray this prayer regularly: "Increase our faith." First this prayer shows that faith is something that can grow. In contemporary society

faith is sometimes seen as just an intellectual belief. If a person believes a set of doctrines, it is thought that they have faith. However, in the Holy Bible, faith is something much more dynamic than mere assent to a set of propositions. As St James states, "You believe

that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!" (James 2:19). Faith is a trust in God and God's power over our lives. Faith also leads to a life of obedience. So as our

faith grows so also does our reliance and trust on God, as well as our obedience to God's commandments.

Yet the first type faith, mere belief, is not opposed to the second type of faith, deep trust. It is the first that gives birth to the second. Without belief in the central tenets of Christianity we cannot grow in our faith. That is what St James is pointing to as well. It is not enough to simply believe that there is a God. That belief must lead to a deeper

inner change. If we don't believe

some wrong teaching on these tenets, then our whole orientation to life would change. For example, some claim to be Christian but do not accept that Jesus Christ is fully divine. This wrong belief

would change our trust in Jesus and in the understanding of Jesus' power in our lives.

The second type of faith must grow. The disciples were aware of their need for their faith to grow. The father of the son with mute spirit told Jesus, "I believe; help my unbelief" (Mark 9:24). Jesus reminds the apostles that even a little faith can be powerful. "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you" (Luke 17:6). Jesus is inviting us to envision faith as somewhat quantifiable or measurable. We do not have any human means to measure this faith. Yet we have all experienced the growth in our faith.

St Paul says, "but having hope, that as your faith is increased, we shall be greatly enlarged by you in our sphere" (2 Cor. 10:15). St Paul believes that if the faith of

the Corinthian church increases, then St Paul's faith will also increase. When our faith increases, the lives of those around us are also changed. This is a great reminder to parents. When faith of parents grows, the children will be positively influenced as well.

How can our faith grow? Growth happens when energy is given to something. When our faith is fed with a regular practices of prayer, Bible reading, meditation, and other godly practices, then our faith will grow. We can think of our faith as a garden. A garden needs regular nurturing and pruning for it to be fruitful and beautiful. As we approach Great Lent, let us all strive for our faith to grow.
