Assistant Vicar's Message

Ordination

If it takes a village to raise a child, then the life of the child as an adult is reflective of the village that raised them. July 1st, 2023 is an occasion for the village that is St. Thomas Unruh to celebrate how

it has raised one of its children: Predeep Chacko. Predeep was raised in church from his birth and was even baptized in the church. As Predeep becomes ordained we can all rejoice in the growth of one of our children. Predeep's ordination to Sub-deaconate will be an important milestone in the long journey towards priestly ministry that he has been travelling.

The order of Sub-deacon is one of the ranks of ordained ministry in the church. The Syriac title is Yavphadiakno which literally means "Doorkeeper". The Yavphadiakno probably served to watch the doors of the church in the ancient days. As the various ranks of angels serve God in his heavenly temple, so the various ranks of earthly ministers serve God and His Church here below. Traditionally it is said that there are 7 ranks of priesthood with (1) Baptism, (2) Chrismation, (3) Singer / Msamrono, (4) Reader / Korooyo, (5) Sub-deacon / Yavphadiakno, (6) Deacon / Mshamshono, (7) Priest / Kaseeso / Kohano. In some lists two other ranks are substituted for 1 and 2. In Malankara we refer to those ordained to ranks 4-7 as deacon or semassan.

Why are ministers ordained in the church? According to St Paul, "And his gifts were

that some should be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ"

(Ephesians 4:11-13). These ministers are ordained to equip the church in its work of ministry, and to build up the body of Christ so that each believer may grow in the image and likeness of God.

The main act in the ordination is the laying on of hands. We see the practice of laying on of hands

to ordain ministers in the New Testament. For example, when the church ordained deacons it says, "These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands upon them" (Acts 6:6). When St Paul was sent out as a missionary, the leaders in Antioch "had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off" (Acts 13:3; see 1 Timothy 5:22).

The ordination service includes several parts and is done in the middle of Holy Qurbana. It begins with "omologia" or profession of faith which is doctrinal and moral exhortation to the candidate of ordination. The candidate declares that he will follow the instructions given by the bishop. Then the bishop clips the hair of the candidate in the shape of cross while saying "(NAME OF ORDINAND) is tonsured and sealed to signify his rejection of carnal habits by the clipping of his lifeless hair off his head." The Bishop then holds the right hand of the ordinand and leads him to the sanctuary saying, "The Holy Spirit calls you to be a sub-deacon in His Holy Church." The candidate then remains in the altar kneeling while several prayers are completed. One such prayer states, "Make this Your servant worthy to receive the divine gift of the laying upon of hands in purity and holiness." Several scripture portions are read including selections from Isaiah by the candidate. After the gospel and creed, the bishop stands on the steps of the altar and calls forth the Holy Spirit. Following two declarations and one proclamation, the bishop lays his hands on the candidate and makes the sign of the cross thrice on the forehead of the candidate.

Let us continue to remember Predeep in our prayers. May God use Predeep for the building up of His Church.
