# Vicar's Message

### Blessed New Year!

Seeing the dawn of 2024 many are excited to review and revise their life from a Christian perspective. The New Year concept is very seriously taken by a vast majority of people. New Year Day is, therefore, not just another day for those people. Many honestly make an attempt to review their life. In our Christian teachings a review of life is a sign of a person's ambition or desire to find out the weak points in life and discard them; while affirming the strong aspects to further strengthen them. For such people life will become a success by all means. That does not mean we have immunity for adversity. Adversities are all mixed in our life along with joy, peace and prosperity. Our ability to react to each of these good or bad situations leads us to success. A life without opposition, feud, sickness, sadness, poverty, hatred etc. is not guaranteed but our Lord gives us one guarantee," I will be with you to the end of the world". When a matter disturbs us our first reaction is against God thinking, "why did you forsake me?" Even Our Lord asked this question on the cross!
