Assistant Vicar's Message

Feast of Ascension

Forty days after the feast of the Resurrection we celebrate the feast of

of

Ascension. The feast Ascension commemorates the Risen Christ's ascension to heaven where sits at the right hand of God the Father. We can understand the importance of this day through several homilies of the fathers on this feast.

Firstly, through the ascension all of humanity was raised to heaven with Christ the New Adam. According to Gregory the Great, "If by the birth of the Lord, the deity seemed lowered, by his Ascension, humanity was glorified" (Homily 29). In the same homily Gregory adds, "For the same nature to which it was said: 'You are earth, and

in the earth you will go' (Gen 3: 19), has today gone to heaven." Through the ascended Christ, our human nature ascends into heaven. Through this we remember the change that Christ has brought to our nature. As Gregory Palamas states, "As we lift up our hearts to Him we shall behold the great spectacle of our nature united for ever with the fire of the divinity." In the ascended Christ our nature is united for ever with the fire of the divinity.

This is the experience of divinization or theosis.

Secondly, even though we are physically on earth, we are able to elevate ourselves to heaven and to place our hope there. As the author of Hebrews says, "We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain"

(Hebrews 6:19). Our hope is in heaven.

Thirdly, through the ascension Christ joins heaven and earth together in a union. The entire purpose of the incarnation for this union. The incarnation is the fulfilment of the prophetic call to "rend the heavens and come down" (Isaiah 64:1). That began with the

annunciation and comes to a real culmination in the ascension. This union will be completed in the second coming with the holy city of new Jerusalem coming down to the new earth (Rev 21). As Gregory Palamas states, "The disciples worshipped the most high Lord who had come down from heaven, made the earth into heaven and gone up again when He came, having united things below with things above and formed one Church, at the same time heavenly and earthly, to the glory of His love for mankind."

Finally, in the feast of the ascension we look forward to the second coming. According to Augustine, the feasts of resurrection and ascension are part of the glorifications of Christ that will be completed in the second coming. Augustine states, "Christ has been twice glorified with respect to the form of man he took to himself; first, by rising from the dead on the third day; next, by ascending into heaven before the eyes of his disciples. There are these two glorifications of his, to which our attention is being drawn, which have already taken place. There remains one more to come, it too in the sight of men, when he presents himself in judgment." According to Gregory Palamas Christians should "have their eyes lifted up to the Master above the heavens, praising and blessing Him with irreproachable conduct, and waiting for His mystical coming."
