## Vicar's Message

## The Resurrection Experience

Saul of Tarsus did not believe in Jesus during His public ministry; he didn't want to believe in him; he knew something is going on in his community in connection with Jesus but never believed His miracles and revolutionary talks; and he did not want to investigate into what's going on because his conviction was that the person namely Jesus who did all these must be a fraud. For Saul the one who broke the sacred laws of Moses, even the Sabbath does not deserve any attention. In addition, He did not respect the leaders of his own religion and even called them "hypocrites". Then Saul decided to bring an end to the followers of this strange leader who turned society upside down with his simple teaching of love. Saul did not want to accept the ideology of this 'fraud'. Then he thought to himself, 'thank God my people were able to reject him and kill him, giving the worst kind of death of a criminal. He thought everything came to an end like what happened to Theudas who had more than four hundred



followers, and Judas the Galilean who also had some followers (Acts 5:35-39). Just the opposite happened when this 'fraud' man's disciples started spreading a 'lie' that their leader has resurrected and appeared to several of them. The news became sensational, and several people started believing this 'lie' and it became unbearable to all religious leaders that they decided to eradicate the followers using all their might.

Later on Saul who took the name Paul, wrote to the Corinthians 15: 4ff., "He (Jesus) was raised on the third day according to scriptures and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve; then he appeared to above five hundred brethren at once....then he appeared to James...and last of all as to child untimely born, he appeared to me (Paul) also." He continued in vs. 14, "if Christ has not been raised then is our preaching in vain, your faith is in vain." It was the amazing turning point in Paul's life. Paul said all the stories to Luke who later recorded it in the Acts of the Apostles chapter 9. On the very unassuming but a targeted trip to Damascus Jesus met Saul through a lightning, asking, "Saul, Saul why do you persecute me?" To Saul's reply, "who are you Lord" the response was... "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting". Saul couldn't believe that the 'fraud Jesus' is the living God! There began a new journey for Saul taking the name Paul.

The encounter with the resurrected Jesus was an 'experience par excellent' to Paul. Paul became the greatest missionary, greater than all other apostles who travelled with Jesus, to spread the Good News to the rest of the world. It was not a comfort seeking journey with Jesus

but a commitment to spread the Truth of Resurrection to the rest of the world. His entire life after the conversion was spent for Christ and His mission. The adventures, the sufferings, and finally his martyrdom were all the proof of his relentless faith in the true God Jesus Christ. This resurrection experience became instrumental to millions of Christians to accept the Way of Christ. This experience is available to us too if we are willing to believe in this living God who will give us a mission to spread that experience to others. As we celebrate Easter this year, let us try to capture this experience of an encounter with this loving God Jesus. He will change us. He will renew us. He will strengthen us.

The Lord is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!
